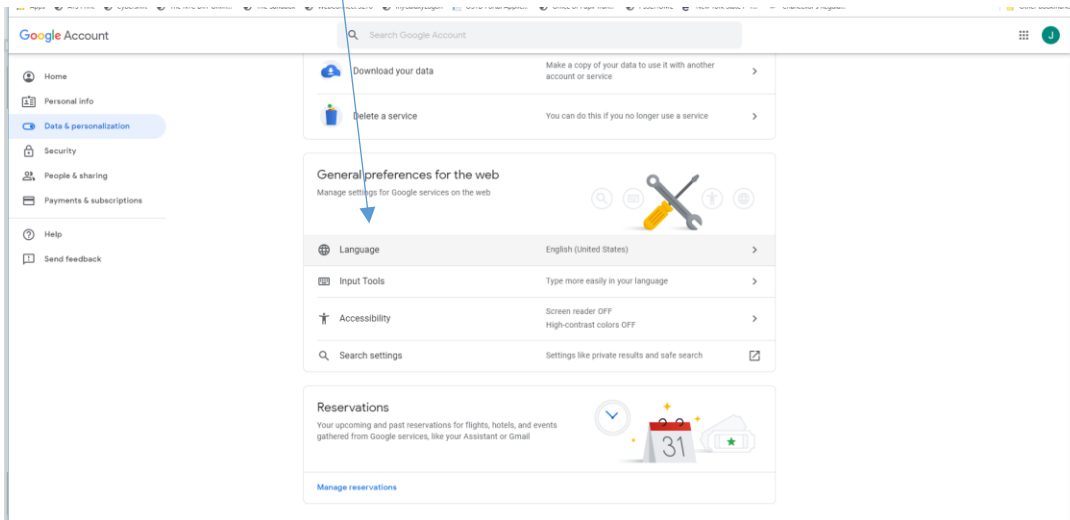
Did you know that you could change your preferred language when using Google Chrome?

Follow these few steps to change your language or add additional languages to your preferences:

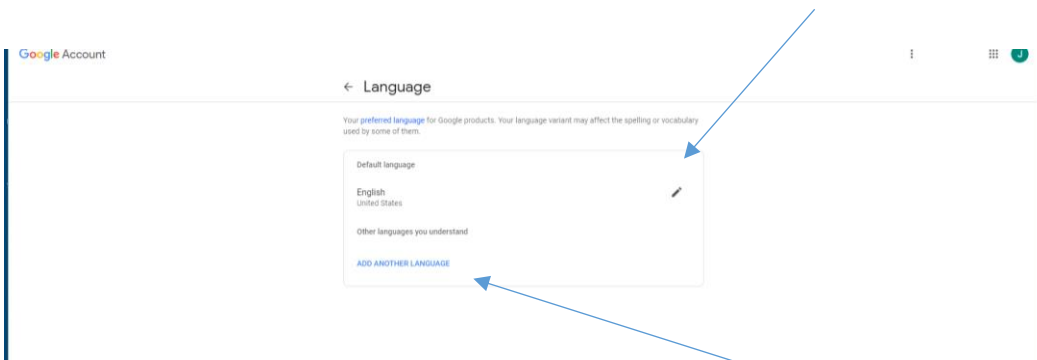
- Open your **Google** Account. You might need to sign in.
