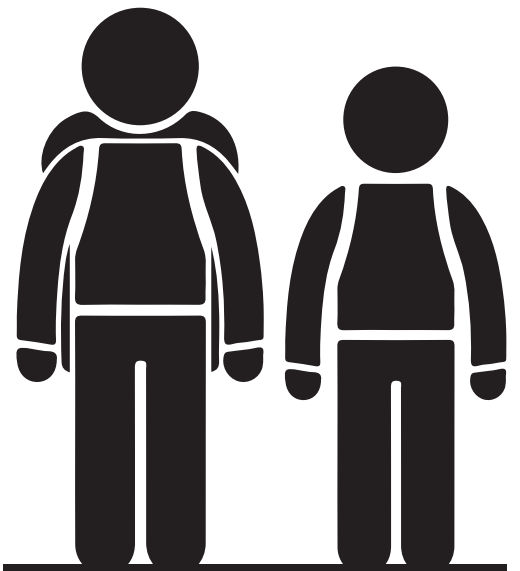


Enroll in NYC Public Schools

Welcome to the NYC Department of Education! Each winter, we collect admissions applications for the following school year.

Missed the application? New to NYC? Have you moved? Want to transfer? Need to enroll or change schools now?

Register for 3-K or Pre-K

- Children six weeks to three years old may be eligible to enroll in Early Learn programs. Learn more at nyc.gov/CCE.
- Children can start 3-K the calendar year they turn three.
- Children can start pre-K the calendar year they turn four.
- Request a call from the Outreach Team at maps.nyc.gov/prek or call 718-935-2009.

Register for Elementary School

- In NYC, children start kindergarten the calendar year they turn five.
- Most children attend their zoned school for elementary school.
- If you have a zoned school, contact your zoned school directly to enroll anytime during the school year.
- If you don't have a zoned school or if you would like to explore other school options for your child, visit a Family Welcome Center.

Register for Middle School

- Students who have completed fifth grade can start middle school.
- If you want to go to your zoned school, contact your zoned school directly to enroll anytime during the school year.
- If you don't have a zoned school or if you would like to explore other school options for your child, visit a Family Welcome Center.

Register for High School

- Students who have completed eighth grade can start high school.
- Visit a Family Welcome Center anytime to discuss school options and to register.

What to Bring to Enroll

- Your child
- Proof of age: One official document that includes your child's date of birth or age
 - Examples: Birth certificate, passport, record of baptism
- Your child's immunization records (if available)
- Your child's latest report card/transcript (if available)
- Proof of address: Two documents that include your current home address—for a full list of accepted documents, see schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents
 - Examples: Lease agreement, deed, or mortgage statement; gas or electric bill; cable bill; last year's income tax form; official NYS driver's license (not expired); pay stub issued within the past 60 days

Do you live in temporary housing? Don't wait to enroll in school! Families in temporary housing do not have to bring documentation to enroll. Schools will work to get the necessary documents after you enroll.
